Pre-registration Training Courses

Before you can submit your application to register you will need to have completed the pre-registration training that is mandatory for all childminders in Wales.

Understand how to set up a home-based childcare service (CYPOP5)

This is the recognised pre-registration training that is required to become a registered childminder. As well as learning relevant aspects of childcare, this knowledge based unit supports the development of policies and procedures relevant to registration, and the basic business skills to set up a home based childcare service.

This course runs over 14 hours with the support of an experienced Tutor. Course textbook included. Assessment is by Multiple Choice Test.

CYPOP5 pre-registration training course, Saturday 9th, 16th and 23rd March 2019 10am – 3.30pm.

Multiple Choice Question (MCQ) Online Exam on Wednesday, 27th March 2019, 5pm – 6pm.

There is a charge of £50 towards the training – the remainder of the balance will be funded by Flintshire County Council.
