## **Background**

Giddo's Gift was established in August 2017 in memory of Jordan Giddins who was taken from our lives aged 18 in April 2017. He was the bravest most inspirational young person who battled hard against HLH and Ewing's Sarcoma from the age of 11. He always thought of others and wanted to help those suffering, he was kind and generous, so Giddo's Gift is a wonderful legacy from him.

We gained registration in Feb 2018 and have grown over the last 3 years helping hundreds of young people aged13-24yrs battling Cancer.

### Our Aims -

To give gifts, such as phones laptops and electronics, to young people as they battle cancer. Our gift will hopefully bring a smile to their face and allow them to keep in contact with family and friends as they go through grueling treatments.

To offer financial help to families as they support their child.

To award a bereavement grant to the next of kin in the horrendous event of a young person's death.

To award a yearly grant to aid research into childhood cancers.

To aim of our fundraising volunteering activity is to promote awareness of our services and to raise vital funds within the local community to support our work.

Volunteer Ambassadors help to raise awareness of our work by attending events to talk about our work and encourage others to get involved in fundraising activity. Our

Ambassadors will also assist with fundraising events and could eventually arrange their own events. This is a really important role as it helps us to reach new people, inspire new fundraising activity, and thank our supporters for the work they are doing.
